¹ While Rep. Mills has sponsored pro-life legislation in the past, he failed to stand for the cause of life when his voice and vote was most desperately needed. He failed to join the discharge petition on pro-life SB 8 (03-14-14) which mandated that abortionists show the ultrasound picture of the unborn child to the mother.
