⁵ Voted no to HB 416 (02-27-13) (House Committee Substitute) which expanded gambling in Kentucky. It created two new lottery games and expanded casino video slot machines to horse tracks under the auspices of shoring up the state pension fund. It passed the House 52-47 (2-27-13).
