¹ Mr. Timoney voted against constitutional amendment legislation that would allow Kentuckians to expand school choice (HB 2 - 2024), Anti-School Choice Jefferson County Teacher’s Union PAC (Better Schools KY PAC) donated \$75,000 to the “Commonwealth Conservative Coalition PAC” in support of Mr. Timoney’s campaign.

² Mr. Jefferson was recommended by Kentucky Right to Life Victory PAC for his pro-life answers.

³ Mr. Timoney voted to allow puberty blockers and gender mutilation surgeries for minors, transgender bathrooms, and LGBTQ curriculum to be taught in K-12 public schools (SB150 - 2023).

⁴ Mr. Timoney voted to allow boys to compete in girls’ sports (SB83 in 2022).

⁵ Mr. Timoney voted to allow DEI concepts to be taught in Kentucky’s colleges and to allow discrimination based on political viewpoints in hiring and promotions (SB6 - 2024).
