1. Voted for SFA #2 in 2023 on HB 470 which would have allowed minors to undergo gender transitions. Sen. Smith however signed CPC's Agreement in Principle Document in 2026.
2. Sen. Smith voted against school choice (HB 9 in 2022 and HB 563 in 2021) but voted for federal school choice (HB1 in 2026)
3. Sen. Smith voted for sports gambling legalization which allowed 18 year olds to gamble (HB 551 in 2023). Voted for HB 904 in 2026 which included increasing the minimum gambling age to 21.
4. Rep. Wesley voted against school choice (HB 9 in 2022 to create educational opportunity accounts.) but voted for federal school choice (HB1 in 2026)
